



THE 18TH ANNUAL NEWS AND DOCUMENTARY EMMY AWARD NOMINEES ANNOUNCED BY
THE NATIONAL ACADEMY OF TELEVISION ARTS AND SCIENCES

New York, July 30 -- The 18th Annual News and Documentary Emmy Award Nominees were announced today by John Cannon, President of the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences. The Awards recognize outstanding achievement by individuals and programs broadcast during the 1996 calendar year.

"The near record number of entries -- nearly 1300 -- reflect broadcasters growing emphasis on news and documentary programming," observed Mr. Cannon. "It is broadcasters response to viewers ever growing interest in news and their concerns about social, political and cultural issues shaping today's world."

A black-tie dinner and ceremony is scheduled on Wednesday, September 10th at the Marriott Marquis Hotel's Broadway Ballroom, New York City.

Following established tradition, national and international newsmakers will present the coveted Emmy Awards.
