THE 19TH ANNUAL NEWS AND DOCUMENTARY EMMY AWARD NOMINEES ANNOUNCED BY
THE NATIONAL ACADEMY OF TELEVISION ARTS AND SCIENCES

New York, July 22 -- The 19th Annual News and Documentary Emmy Award Nominees were announced today by John Cannon, President of the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences. The Awards recognize outstanding achievement by individuals and programs broadcast during the 1997 calendar year.

"The large number of entries -- nearly 1200 -- reflect broadcasters continuing emphasis on news and documentary programming," observed Mr. Cannon. "It is broadcasters response to viewers lasting interest in news and their concerns about social, political and cultural issues shaping today's world."

A black-tie dinner and ceremony is scheduled on Wednesday, September 9th at the Marriott Marquis Hotel's Broadway Ballroom, New York City.

Following established tradition, national and international newsmakers will present the coveted Emmy Awards.
