



THE 19TH ANNUAL NEWS AND DOCUMENTARY EMMY AWARDS PRESENTED BY THE NATIONAL ACADEMY OF TELEVISION ARTS AND SCIENCES

New York, September 9 -- The 19th Annual News and Documentary Emmy Awards were presented by the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences tonight. A group of prominent newsmakers presented the awards to a distinguished group of electronic journalists. John Cannon, President of the National Academy presided at the event following a black-tie dinner at the Marriott Marquis Hotel.

"The coveted Emmy was awarded to programs and program segments as well as to individuals for outstanding achievement in News and Documentary programming," Mr. Cannon said. "The recipients were chosen by blue ribbon panels of peers from nearly 1,200 entries from the eligibility period of the 1997 calendar year."
